Components for the SHSM

A bundle of Grade 11 and Grade 12 credits that include:

- 4 major credits that provide sector-specific knowledge and skills
- 3 or 4 other required credits from the Ontario curriculum, in English and Mathematics, in which some expectations are met through learning activities contextualized to the sector
- 2 Co-operative Education (Co-op) credits that provide authentic learning experiences in a workplace setting, enabling students to refine, extend, apply, and practice sector-specific knowledge and skills
 sector-recognized certifications and training courses from a Ministry approved list
 - "Reach Ahead" experiences in the area of the student's post-secondary destination of choice
- development of Essential Skills and work habits required in the sector, and use of the Ontario Skills
 Passport (OSP) for documentation purposes



Achievement Recognition:

Employers, parents and students will be pleased to note that SHSM students receive formal recognition for their participation in the program. Successful students are honoured with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma embossed with a red seal, and a Specialist High Skills Major Record Sheet outlining their achievement in the required components.
